CODE OF CONDUCT

The International Press committee is a committee of exclusive nature and has characteristics of its own. Therefore, to ensure proper functioning and uniformity in the conference and the committee, there are certain policies and regulations dedicated to only International Press delegates:

- Caricaturists are expected to be respectful and polite to every delegate, staff member, and conference executive. When in committee, caricaturists should not cause any sort of disruption. Do not indulge in any form of reporting, which has your personal likes or dislikes for a person/country/religion.
- Do not make any caricatures without adequate amount of knowledge; make sure your reports are accurate.
- ◆ One should remember the fact they are representing a news outlet.
- One is not necessarily required to write draw exactly on the proceedings of the committee session. Choose a specific topic or any instance during the committee and elaborate on it.
- Caricatures should be unbiased, and any personal feelings should not affect the reports.
- The caricaturists have to be very innovative and creative while making caricatures and will be assessed accordingly.
- Check your caricatures before submission so that they are well drawn, with no errors. This will make the work of editors a little less burdened. Submit the materials in accordance with the deadline.
