Topic: Strengthening Secure Digital Infrastructure and AI Governance with a Focus on Emerging Economies

As the delegate of Germany, I firmly believe that the massive growth of global digital networks and Artificial Intelligence (AI) must be guided by universal human rights, strict data privacy, and systemic safety. Technology is evolving at an astronomical pace, but I stand firm in my belief that innovation should never bypass ethical boundaries. If you look closely at developing nations, you will see they need to be empowered to construct tech frameworks that are secure by design. I urge you all to ensure they are not forced to rely on high-risk corporate monopolies or manipulative foreign investments that trap them in heavy debt.

As a key leader in the European Union, my country has pioneered a proactive, risk-based approach to technology. Through the landmark EU AI Act and our data sovereignty initiative, GAIA-X, I am proud to demonstrate to you that a nation can encourage a thriving tech sector while still legally mandating absolute transparency. I firmly reject the chaotic idea of a completely unregulated digital playground. You cannot allow multinational corporations to exploit user data, nor can we permit malicious cyber networks to destabilize global financial structures.

To bridge the worldwide digital divide safely, I enthusiastically support the **EU Global Gateway**—our €300 billion initiative designed to fund transparent, secure, and sustainable digital infrastructure across emerging economies. I strongly advise you to reject cheap, poorly made hardware options that contain hidden security flaws and create economic dependency.

To resolve these critical issues, I ask you to join me in achieving three main goals for our ITU resolution:

1. **The Risk-Based Standard:** I call on you to support a global ITU guideline that classifies AI systems by their level of risk, forcing creators to guarantee safety before high-impact tools are launched in emerging markets.
2. **Sovereign and Sustainable Tech:** I aim to utilize our Global Gateway to help you deploy decentralized, eco-friendly data centers in the Global South, ensuring your nations maintain total ownership of your own citizens' data.
3. **Cyber-Forensic Action:** I urge you to implement strict international protocols to trace, block, and penalize state-sponsored cybercriminals who target vulnerable financial networks.
